

Associa Cares is about community. Our mission is to assist families and communities in crisis as a result of natural or man-made disasters. We provide assistance to those in need wherever they may be. Our efforts not only work to provide direct, financial relief in the form of grants to impacted families, but also to provide them the assurance that there is a community of people who care. None of this would be possible without the efforts of Associa employees, our business partners, and those who find it in their heart to help others. Our efforts in 2019 spanned 26 states and provinces. We worked to respond to tornadoes, historic flooding, and to smaller disasters like house or condominium fires. As this report shows, Associa Cares provided financial support for 233 families as the result of 82 disaster events and distributed a total of \$235,986. Since our founding in 2007, we have distributed nearly \$3.8 million in assistance.

Our goal is to get people back on their feet as quickly as possible by providing direct financial assistance. We are only able to do this because we have more than a network of people who help build resources and identify disasters and those in need - we have a community. 

# CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTIONS & OPERATIONAL EXPENSES\*


